ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

Apparel Impact's mission to is reduce clothing, shoes and other textiles from local waste streams, while building a strong local business that provides community support and jobs for local people.

- All Accessories (Purses, Backpacks, Scarves, Ties, Hats, etc.)
- All Shoes (Sneakers, Dress, Heels, Flats, Sandals, etc.)
- Sheets / Blankets

All Items Must Be Dry, Contain No Mold, or Bad Odor.
